What's New?

GRAVITY BASE STRUCTURE (GBS)

- Cantilever walls and roof on the GBS are completed
- Both concrete batch plants have been disassembled and relocated to barges. They will be part of the flotilla at the deep water site (DWS) this summer
- Construction of the GBS at the DWS will continue until the ice and storage cell walls reach a height of 72 meters and the centre shaft reaches a height of approximately 120 m

TOPSIDES

- Topsides structural steel and aluminum assembly work continues for the living quarters
- Work on the first living quarters cabin has begun, as the future “home away from home” for the Hebron operations team comes together
- Pier upgrades have begun
